

4. Water Connection. The connection charge for cutting in a new service shall be all costs of installation incurred including, but not limited to, materials, labor, equipment and cutting in and restoring highway or street crossings. In all cases, the minimum charge shall be one hundred seventy-five dollars (\$175.00). All existing buildings having indoor facilities shall connect to the Borough water lines. All newly erected buildings having indoor water facilities shall connect to Borough water lines before occupancy. No building serviced by Borough water lines shall cross-connect to an alternate water source pursuant to Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection regulations.
5. Responsibilities of Service. The Borough water Department shall maintain the meters and water connections from the main line to the curb. The property owner shall be responsible for supply lines from the curb to the building being serviced and include a frost free area and an accessible place for meter reading.

Section 2. The provisions of Chapter 26, §102 of the Elkland Borough Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

§102 General Policies:

1. Deposits. A deposit of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) shall be made for water service, sewer service or combined service if installed at the same time, together with a twenty dollar (\$20.00) nonrefundable service fee to cover connection, disconnection and meter reading services. This deposit shall be made by the property owner and will be returned at the end of one calendar year, provided all billings for service have been paid or at the time services are discontinued, all billings are paid. At the discretion of the Borough, any deposit may be applied upon a delinquent bill unpaid for thirty (30) days after due date. In cases in which the deposit is exhausted, services shall be discontinued until all charges are paid in full and an additional deposit of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) is made.
2. Delinquent Customers. If services are required to be turned off because of a delinquency in excess of thirty (30) days, a service charge of twenty dollars (\$20.00) shall be added to the billing to disconnect and reconnect the water service. In all cases in which water service is disconnected, an additional deposit of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) shall be required before water service will be restored.
3. Billing Responsibilities. It shall be the responsibility of the property owner to pay all deposits and to pay all billings. It shall be the responsibility of the property owner to notify the Borough of a change in tenants and to request a final meter reading for that tenant.
