

Responsibility of Service - The Water Department will be responsible for maintaining the meters and water connections from the main line to the curb. The consumer shall be responsible for supply lines from the curb to the building being served including a frost free area and an accessible place for meter reading.

SECTION 2

GENERAL POLICIES

Deposit - A deposit of \$50.00 shall be made for water service, sewer service or combined service if installed at the same time, plus a \$20.00 non-refundable service fee to cover connection, disconnection and meter reading services. Where the deposit is made by the property owner and the meter billing is in the owner's name, the \$50.00 deposit shall be returned at the end of one year provided all billing has been promptly paid or at the time services are discontinued and all billings paid. Where billings are delinquent for a period of sixty days, such \$50.00 deposit shall be retained until such time as all billings are paid promptly for the period of one year. Where a tenant makes the deposit and billings are in the tenant's name, the \$50.00 deposit shall be held until services are discontinued and all billings paid. At the discretion of the borough, any deposit may be applied upon a delinquent bill unpaid sixty days after due date. In cases in which the deposit is exhausted, services shall be discontinued until all charges are paid in full and an additional deposit of \$50.00 is made.
